Dr. O'Mahony is a Research Fellow in Cost-Effectiveness Analysis at the [Centre for Health Policy & Management](#), School of Medicine, TCD. James holds a BA in economics and philosophy from TCD, an MA in economics from UCD and a PhD from TCD. During his doctoral research James spent two years at the Department of Public Health at the Erasmus Medical Centre in Rotterdam, during which he worked with the MISCAN microsimulation model of cancer prevention. James spent the final year of his PhD studies working at the Health Information and Quality Authority (HIQA).

James now works at Trinity College Dublin, and has worked as a postdoctoral researcher with the CERVIVA research consortium with clinical research specialists from Trinity's Department of Histopathology at the Coombe Hospital, Dublin. James recently began his first research programme as Principal Investigator under the Health Research Board's Emerging Investigator Award scheme. This research continues his interest in the choices modelling methods have on resulting cost-effectiveness estimates and consequent policy recommendations. James has special interests in the role of [comparators within cost-effectiveness analysis](#), the [decision rules within CEA](#) and in issues regarding health service [waiting lists](#).
